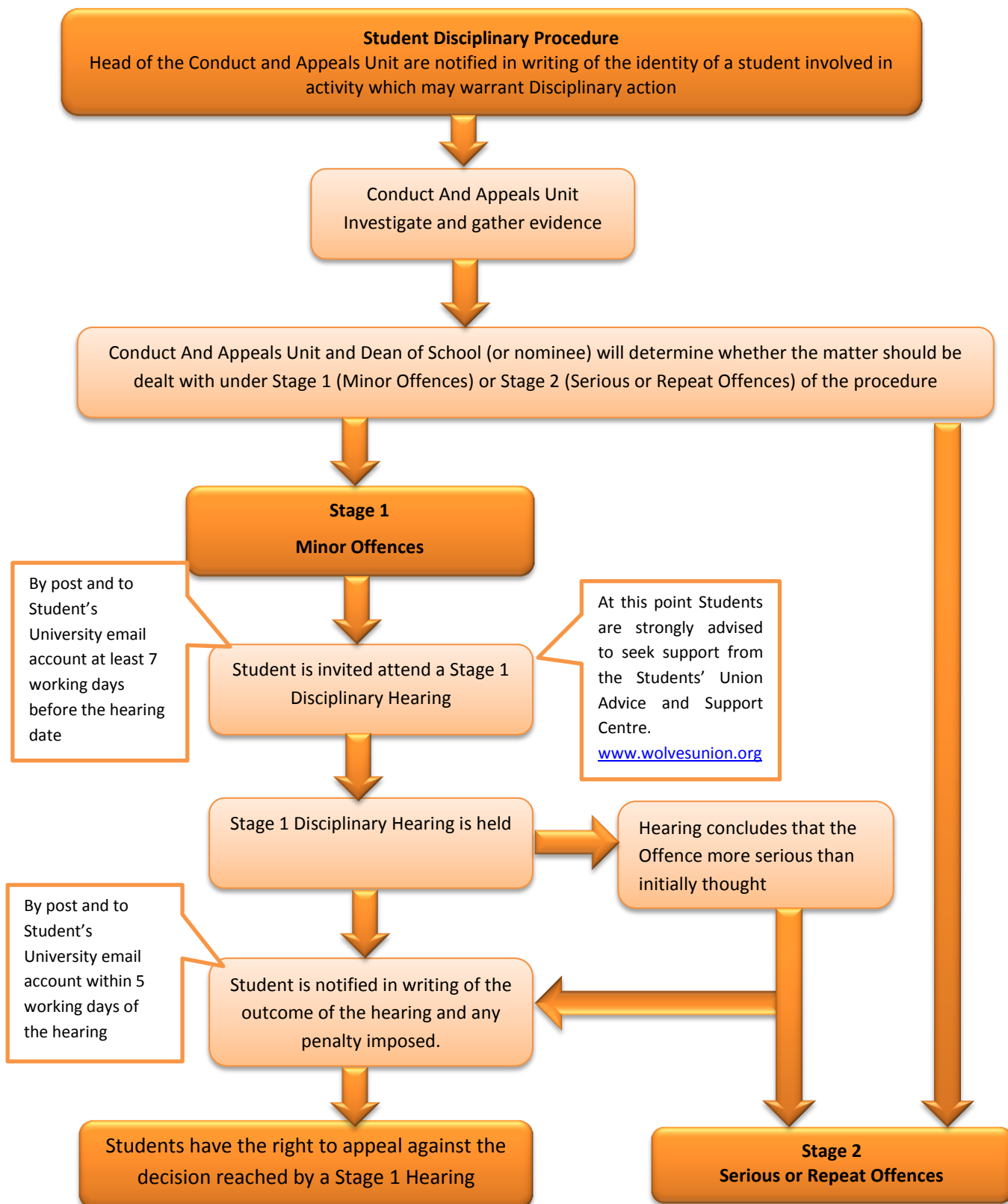


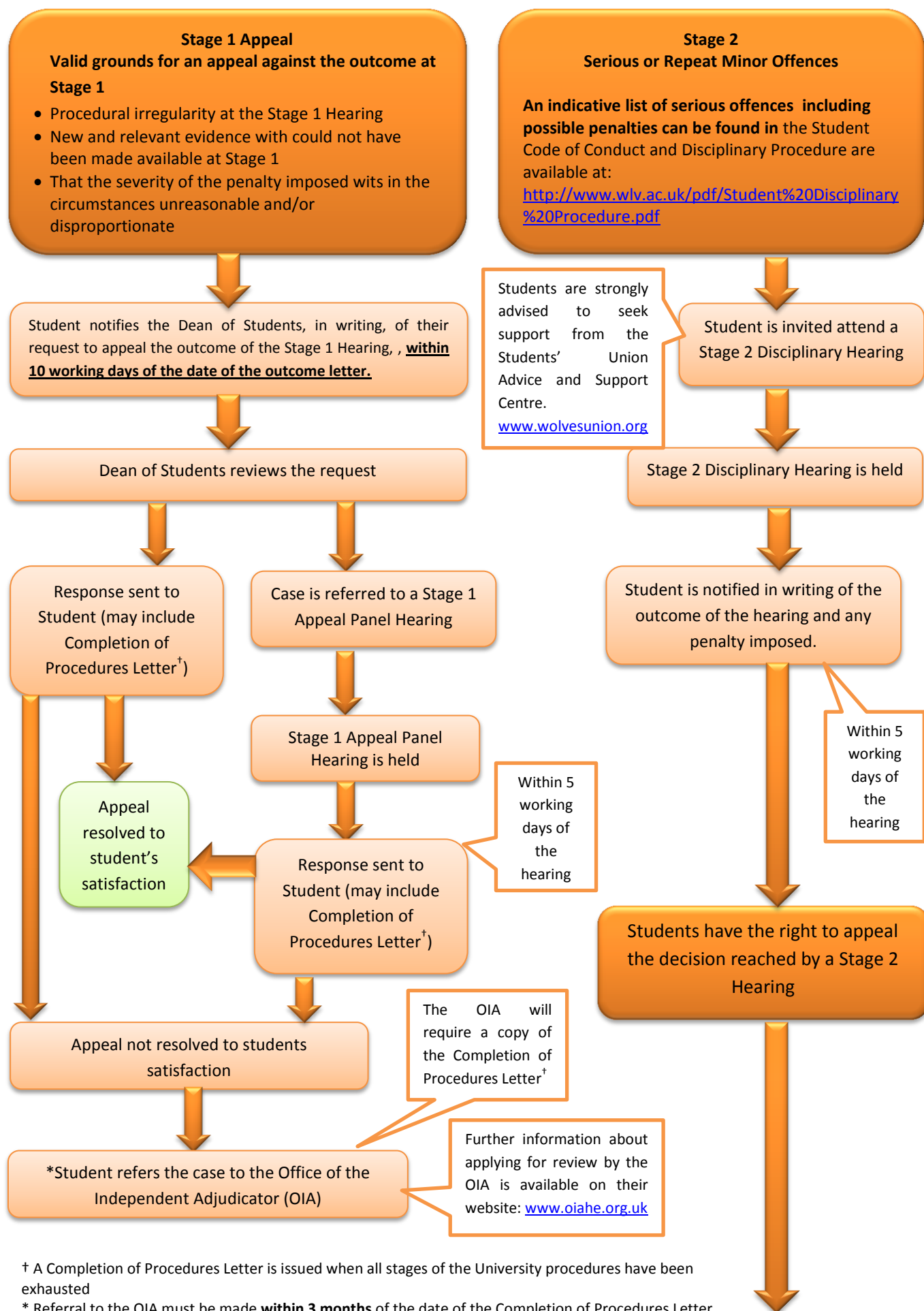

Student Disciplinary Procedure: Flow Chart

Students who fail to meet these standards may be subject to the Disciplinary Procedure.

**Stage 2 Appeal**

**Valid grounds for an appeal against the outcome of a Stage 2 Hearing**

- Procedural irregularity at the Stage 2 Hearing
- New and relevant evidence with could not have been made available at Stage 2
- That the severity of the penalty imposed was in the circumstances unreasonable and/or disproportionate

Student notifies the Clerk to the Board of Governors, in writing, of their request to appeal the outcome of the Stage 2 Disciplinary Hearing, clearly stating the grounds for the appeal, **within 10 working days of date on which the outcome was notified to the student**

Clerk to the Board of Governors reviews the request

Grounds for appeal not demonstrated

Grounds for appeal demonstrated

Response sent to Student (may include Completion of Procedures Letter<sup>†</sup>)

Case is referred to the Students' Disciplinary Appeals Committee of the Board of Governors

Stage 2 Appeal resolved to student's satisfaction

Students' Disciplinary Appeals Committee of the Board of Governors Hearing is held

Response sent to Student (may include Completion of Procedures Letter<sup>†</sup>)

Stage 2 Appeal not resolved to students satisfaction

Stage 2 Appeal resolved to student's satisfaction

The OIA will require a copy of the Completion of Procedures Letter<sup>†</sup>

\*Student refers the case to the Office of the Independent Adjudicator (OIA)

† A Completion of Procedures Letter is issued when all stages of the University procedures have been exhausted
